FOR ALL SIMPLE LEGAL MATTERS, not of a specialised UK nature, we recommend the website www.mylawyer.com This website has been featured often on TV and consumer reports as excellent. The founder and creator is an established, respected attorney. Click around and educate yourself a little about Florida law but do-it-yourself law is not advised. Websites are fine for research only. We recommend you pay one of FABB's British attorneys to handle any important legal matters for you or peruse any forms/documents you are thinking of signing. Remember the law varies in the USA from state to state--and all lawyers practising in Florida must be licensed in Florida. NEVER use non-Florida lawyers for a Florida matter is FABB's advice.

° PUBLIC SERVICE CORNER, especially for newcomer Brits: Florida is the most fraudulent state in the USA—official FBI statistics. If you have been scammed or suspect one, this is where you report it: The Attorney General's office is www.myfloridalegal.com or Tollfree 1-866-9NO-SCAM.

WILLS: If you're a Brit living in Florida, [and therefore more likely to die here, make your will in Florida. If you ever move back to the UK, then make a new one over there. Do it yourself by getting standard State of Florida forms from any Office Depot. Or there's a website called www.legacywriter.com which has them for all USA states.

IN THE UK: The website www.thewillsite.co.uk is an online resource for England and Wales. Create your own will, ask questions, have it reviewed by UK solicitors and more.
